Joseph, the donkeys, sheep and the 3 Kings travelling to Bethlehem. They have also built fantastic structures using a variety of wooden blocks and loose parts.

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Maths

In Maths, we are learning about the size of objects so that we can order and describe the size of the presents for baby Jesus. The children have also enjoyed problem solving and working out which boxes or Russian dolls fit inside each other. They relished the challenge of finding the 2 Russian dolls which weren't part of the complete set. They have also applied their skills in the construction areas of provision to build



small, medium and big structures and explore the size and relationships of the wooden blocks.
