

In **Literacy**, I will be looking at stories from other cultures. This will be linked to topic where we will find out all about Africa. After that, I will be using researched facts to be able to write a report about South Africa.



In **Maths** I will continue to learn about the four number operations; add, subtract, multiply and divide. I will be learning about multiplication and division. For this, it is important that I practise my times tables for quicker recall. I will then learn about statistics and will be able to represent data in different ways.

Subject Focus: **Geography**
