In **Literacy**, I will be focussing on writing and producing a Nature documentary based on an animal.

Later on in the half term, I will be writing a fable, inspired by Rudyard Kipling.



In **Maths** I will be developing my area knowledge.

I will be consolidating and extending my skills when calculating larger multiplication and division sums using the written methods.



In **Science**, I will be investigating and comparing the life cycles of different animals. In addition to this, I will be exploring the human life cycle and how humans change as they age. Topic title: What is the difference between living and surviving?

Subject Focus: Geography
