## The Three Billy Goats Gruff



On Monday, we shared the troll's version of the 'Three Billy Goats Gruff' story. The children joined in the repeated refrains such as 'Who's that trip trapping over my bridge?' and 'I'm going to gobble you up' and discussed if the troll was mean or kind! The children have thoroughly enjoyed dressing up as the 'troll patrol', building bridges using a variety of resources and using the bridges to reenact the story. We collected natural materials to weave into our stick weaving frames just like the troll under the bridge.

Throughout the week, we have had lots of fun exploring our outdoor area using binoculars and magnifying glasses to observe the herbs and flowers. On Wednesday, the children discovered

that our outdoor role-play area has become a farm and shop. We have

been milking the cow and caring for the 2 hens and their chicks, as well as selling produce from the farm. We cannot wait for our trip to Cannon Hall Farm on Monday to learn more about animal life cycles.

## Literacy


