### Cannon Hall Farm



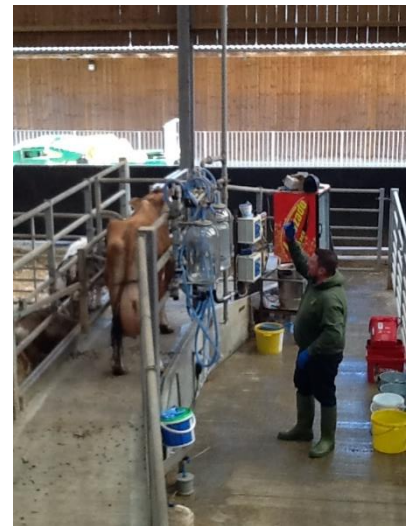
On Monday, we visited Cannon Hall Farm to fuel our learning on animal lifecycles and the circle of life. We had such a wonderful time and the children thoroughly enjoyed this real-life learning opportunity. In the morning, Farmer Ruth gave us a tour of the farm and a useful insight

into the types / breeds of animals on the farm. We discovered that Sows have between 8-16 piglets and that a cows tongue is as long as our arm! The children treasured stroking Midget Gem the rabbit and Squeaker the Guinea Pig at the end of the tour and feeding all the rare

breed animals with pellets down the chutes. After lunch we observed the Meerkats and Reptiles before watching the Farmer give us a fascinating milking demonstration. We finished our trip by playing in the tube mazes and going on a tractor ride.



During the rest of the week, we have created giant working ants for our construction area and built farms and homes for the animals. The children have also been busy using the smart board to record their observations of animals and enjoyed the vet and farm role-play areas.

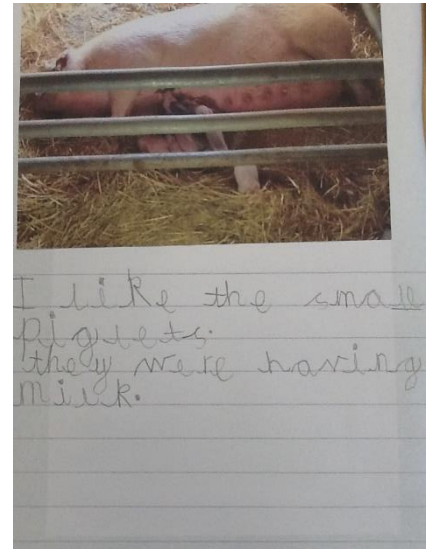
### Literacy
