Our learning this week

This week, we have focussed our learning around our core text 'Whatever Next' by Jill Murphy building on the children's interests and fascinations. Throughout the week, the children have enjoyed creating model rockets, making 'mud paint' in our Artist Studio, creating delicious 'moon picnic' dishes in the mud kitchen and exploring the sand and water areas with greater independence. The children have also been creating inspiring music and



movement using our new outdoor music and stage area of provision and telling fabulous stories to their friends with the story logs and finger puppets. Yesterday, the children decided to become experts in Wizardry designing their own head wear and wands made from natural resources such as sticks and leaves. They particularly enjoyed inventing their own spells and potions.

In PE, we flew up the chimney and landed on the moon where we focussed on developing our fundamental movement skills negotiating space and listening carefully to instructions. At the end of the lesson, the children had such fun following my leader in colour teams in time with the music!
