English - Writing

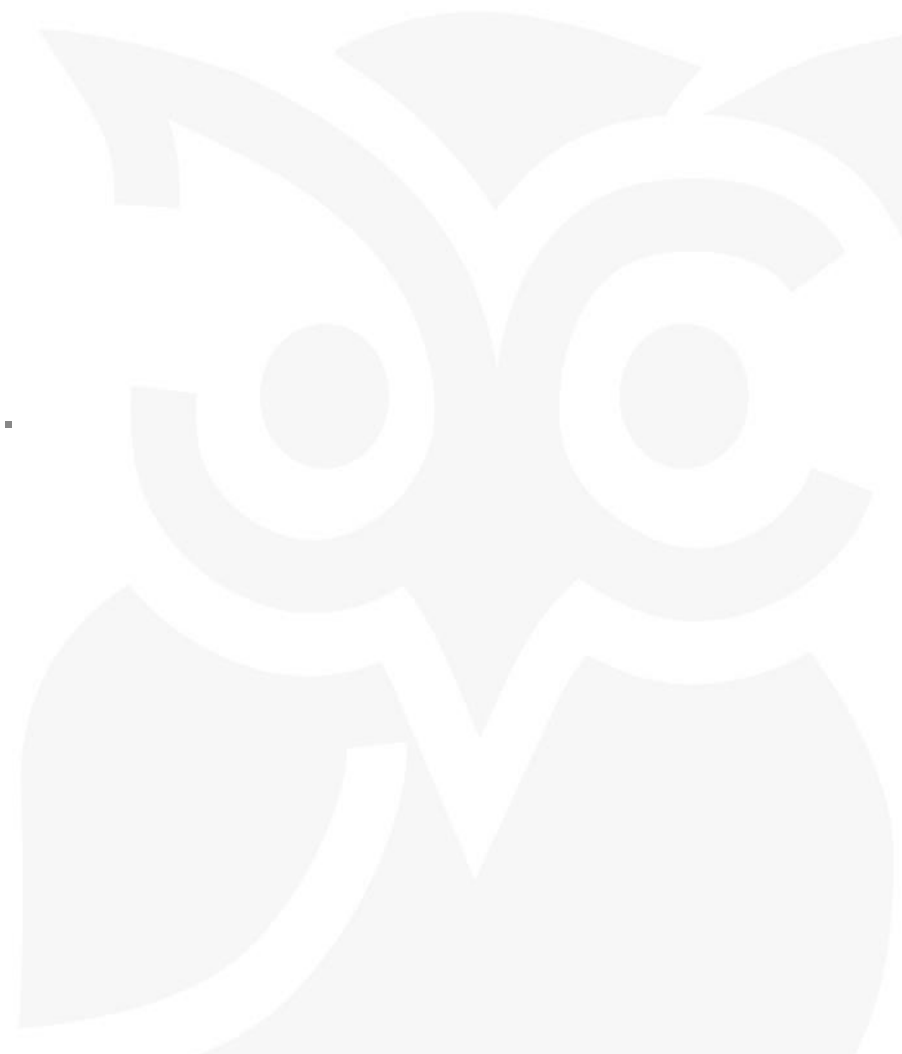

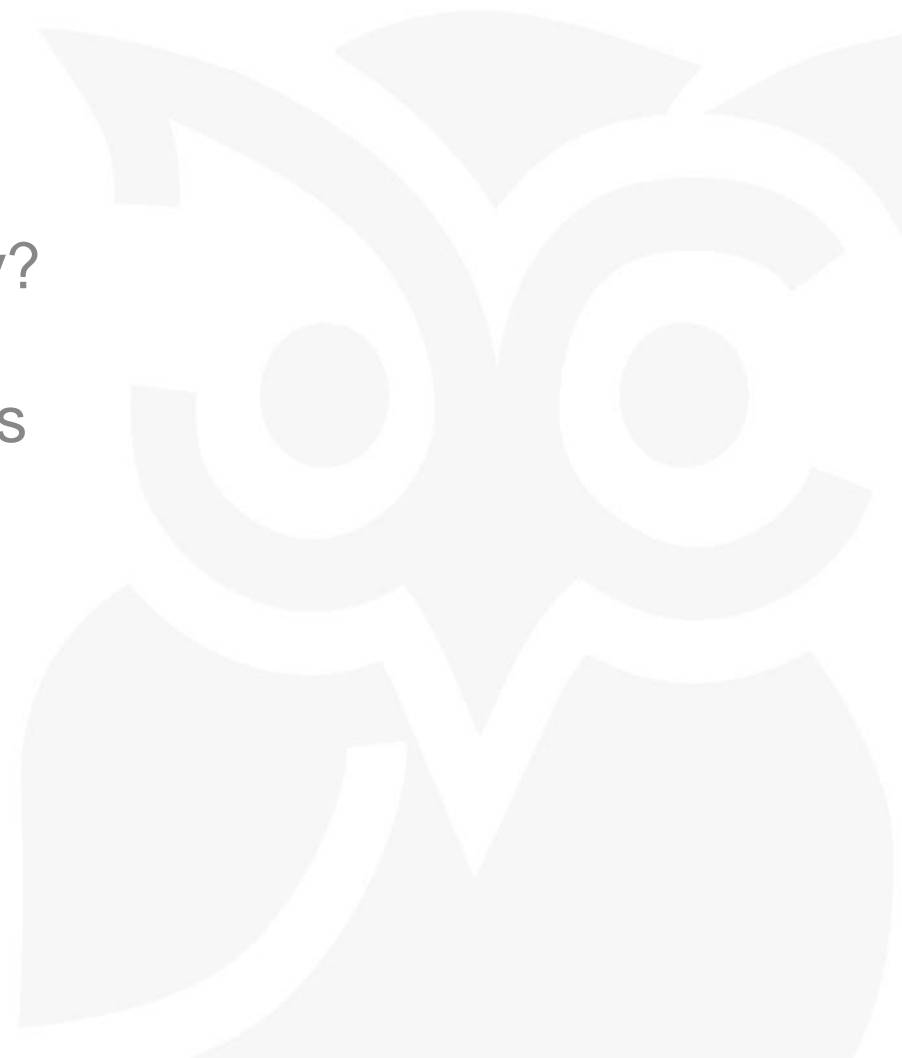
