

### What to expect from Year 5

#### Some of the main elements:

#### **English**

- Continuing to develop knowledge of spelling patterns and exceptions.
- Punctuation, more elaborate and extensive use for particular reasons and audiences, considering formality.
- Planning and editing writing
- Using a wider range of sentence structures with confidence

#### <u>Maths</u>

- All times tables and related division facts, instantly recalled
- Confident use of all written methods for calculations
- Relationships between fractions, decimals and percentages
- Development of shape, space and measure skills, converting of all measures and use of formula to calculate area and perimeter


<u>Autumn Term</u> – **Discover** – The Great Divide
