
## **Frozen Planet**

Many of our children are beginning to set their own challenges during child initiated sessions. On Monday, they thought it would be an excellent idea to channel the water all the way from the water tray across the playground to the sand world. This involved team work, problem solving, dexterity and mathematical exploration. On Wednesday, the children were so excited to investigate



our new outdoor maths area. They particularly enjoyed lifting the tyres onto the broom stick handles, counting and sorting objects as well as recording their observations on the chalk boards. We can't wait until it is fully completed! On Tuesday, Miss Brook took the children for an exciting penguin themed PE session and on Thursday, we made chocolate chip biscuits to eat around the camp fire.
