The Little Green Hen



On Monday, we shared The Little Green Hen by Alison Murray to begin our new theme for learning, 'The Circle of Life'. The children have been exploring the concept of looking after their environment and growing,

as well as building intricate apple trees in the construction and sand areas of provision using excellent mathematical language and vocabulary from our story such as 'hollow' and 'pruning'. Next week, we will continue to build on this further exploring animal and



plant lifecycles and preparing for our trip to Cannon Hall Farm.

During this week, the children have enjoyed sketching beautiful daffodils and blossom in our new

creative space. We have also been learning how to use watercolours, looking closely at the shape, pattern and colour with magnifying glasses. We are extremely impressed at their perseverance and attention to detail and we cannot wait to see how their skills develop over the coming weeks.

Maths


In Maths, we are learning to represent numbers in different ways so that we can help the Little Green Hen accurately count the eggs into the egg boxes. The children have enjoyed counting, sorting, sharing and adding the chicks together and building hencoops to house the hens and eggs.
