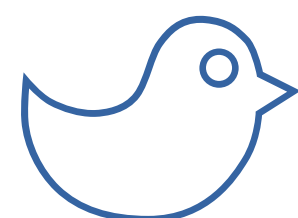


Developing our communication connection with you even more

Seesaw

Seesaw is a live learning journal which children from Year 1 to Year 6 can use to share their home learning with their Class Teacher.

Seesaw will be available for children from Year 1 to Year 6. Reception parents will continue to access Tapestry. We would like our children to use this app to upload some of their work and also access up to 2 tasks a day from your child's Class Teacher.

You will continue to be sent a learning plan on a Monday morning; however, Seesaw can be used for your child to upload their work and gain feedback and also to complete at least 2 daily tasks which your child's Class Teacher will set each day on Seesaw.

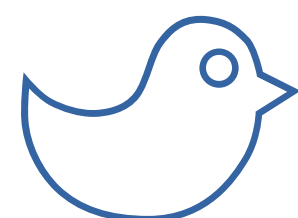
Reading book swap on Wednesday 22nd, Thursday 23rd & Friday 24th April
