Writing

We are starting our new theme 'Incredible creatures' I will be reading our new story focus- The Jungle Book. I would like your child listen to the story on the JCAWakefield YouTube page and then answer these questions who are the main Characters? What happens in the story (brief summary)? What WOW vocabulary did you hear?

Tuesday- Story map the story using pictures and key words

Wednesday- draw either Baloo or Mowgli and add adjectives and similes to describe them.

Thursday- Using the adjectives from yesterday write a character description about your character.

All the activities are explained in detail with examples on Seesaw.

Science:

Can you label the different parts of the body? What do we use to taste, touch, smell, see and hear with?

There will be a worksheet on Seesaw but can you think of a way to draw round yourself and label your own body? For example a long roll of paper or chalk on the floor.
