Music

Follow the instructions on the letter regarding the website and what you can access.

Writing

We have started our story of Jungle Book. This week we will be focussing on speech in our stories and using exclamation marks and question marks. The letter emailed has a clear timetable of activities. Some of these activities will also be on Seesaw.

Science: - Senses games!

- Go on a 'sound' walk and write down all the things they hear.
- Make a smell quiz game by putting something in a cup and covering it- can they guess what it is? E.g. vinegar, shampoo, coffee.
- Learn about Louis Braille who invented the Braille system for blind people
- Blindfold your child and guide them around or give them objects and ask them to identify it
- We have 5 senses sweet, salty, sour and 'unami' or savoury. Let your child taste things that would have this taste eg lemon for sour and see if they can locate where it is sour on their tongue.
