### Hit the button

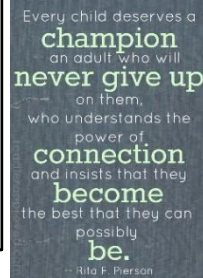
Please practise **doubles to 10**. Once you have mastered this level work up to doubles to 50. **Remember double means the same as times by 2!**

## Writing

For our new Summer term topic 'What's the weather' we will be focussing on a new text for Literacy. In Literacy, we will be focussing on poetry and our outcome will be to create a shape poem based on a chosen weather. We will be striving to use onomatopoeia, adjectives, similes and even rhyme in our poems. I will structure this over the next few weeks before we create our outcome of our shape poem. This week, we will begin to explore different weathers and how we can describe them in detail.
