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Maths

The focus is now on using Seesaw to complete a daily Maths activity, using the White Rose Maths Hub website and the templates on Seesaw. They all did a brilliant job with these last week!

I have assigned some spellings on Spelling Shed to have a practise at completing, please practise these on spelling shed or at home ready for our spelling test.



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Science - Plants
