How to make... **Hot Cross Cookies**

Ingredients Equipment


200g of softened butter, plus extra Oven for the trays 100g of light muscovado sugar

1 tsp of cinnamon 2 tsp of baking powder 100g of sultanas 200g of white chocolate chips
