Learning plan, suggested timetable and learning packs

I have updated the learning plan for this week. These match the resources outlined on the suggested timetable. You will notice that much of this is similar to last week – this is because Literacy and Maths are being uploaded to SeeSaw daily. Science or other activities will be on a Friday. Hopefully, this gives some routine of what you expect to see on SeeSaw for Y6.

However, please do remember to continue to work at a pace that works for you and your children – and do not worry if you are doing this in a different order/ different time of day / doing completely different learning altogether! SeeSaw and the learning plans are simply there to provide some guidance!

SeeSaw (Sharing work and giving feedback)

Again, thank you so much for your ongoing support with using SeeSaw – we're all learning new skills and the children are all doing brilliantly with this!

Just a reminder that although the activities have dates, the tasks do not necessarily need to be done on that day – it is just an indication and so that children can easily see which order things were posted.

Maths White Rose answers are online Monday to Thursday however, I will send answers for SeeSaw Science and Maths Problem solving on a Friday morning via email, where needed. This is to support with self-marking and immediate feedback.

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Online spelling test

The Spelling Shed <u>online test</u> will continue on a weekly basis on a <u>Friday at 11am</u>. Spellings will change weekly and you should be able to access games to *practise these throughout the week*. You should be able to access everything through the website if you do not have the app_https://www.spellingshed.com/en-gb

- Make sure the sound is turned on.
- I will text a code to you 15 minutes before the test.
- Just before the test begins (about 10.55am) children should log on to Spelling Shed as normal, from the panel on the left click 'Join Hive Game' and then enter the code that was sent to you via text. I will also put the code on SeeSaw, as I did last week.
- The text will start at approximately 11am once I can see pupils logging on.

Online blog

The Y6 online blog that was set up before Easter is still live. Again, this is not a requirement but is intended as a place for Y6 to communicate, support each other during their home learning and give positive encouragement to each other.

I would ask children not to post photos or work to this – these should be on SeeSaw or Twitter 🕲
