Challenge 1 Create and build your favourite scene from our shared story. Which characters does George help? How does he help them? Take a photo.

PE / Dance

Challenge 1 Dance with Miss Hoyte. See video link. Challenge 2 Practise throwing, catching, running, hopping, jumping, skipping, balancing and kicking skills. Challenge 3 Create a 'giant' themed dance. Develop giant actions and body shapes.
