Subject: RE Year Group: 2 Term: Autumn 1 "What does it mean to belong to a faith community?"

#### **Core Learning of This Unit:**

- Talk about stories of people who belong to groups; groups to which children belong, including their families and school, what they enjoy about them and why they are important to them.
- Find out about some symbols of 'belonging' used in Christianity and at least one other religion, and what they mean
- Explore the idea that everyone is valuable and how Christians show this through infant baptism and dedication, finding out what the actions and symbols mean.
- Compare this with a welcoming ceremony from another religion
- Find out how people can show they belong with another person e.g. through the promises made in a wedding ceremony, through symbols

#### **Prior Learning:**

- Some children may have been to a baptism or been baptised themselves
- Some children may have been to a wedding
- Children understand what a wedding is and the promise a husband and wife makes
- Children understand the term 'belong' and 'community'.
- Children recognise some key religious symbols or symbols associated with baptism and/or weddings.

- Recognise some different symbols and actions which express a community's way of life, appreciating some similarities between communities.
- Notice and respond sensitively to some similarities between different religions and worldviews.
- Find out about questions of right and wrong and begin to express their ideas and opinions in response.
