Subject: RE Year Group: 2 Term: Summer 2 "What can we learn from Sacred Books?"

Core Learning of This Unit:

• Explore what a story is and why we like them; are there different types of story? Introduce a parable as a story with a deeper meaning.

- Talk about how some books are sacred or holy, meaning that people believe that they are from God.
- Introduce the Bible as a sacred text for Christians; Introduce a sacred text for Muslims Holy Qur'an, and/or Jewish people Tenakh.
- Investigate how these books are used and treated e.g. Torah is often read from scrolls in the synagogue
- Read, act out and illustrate some stories Jesus told about what God is like
- Explore stories from Jewish sacred text, the Tenakh.
- Explore stories about Prophet Muhammad

I Share an example of a story that occurs in more than one sacred text e.g. the story of Noah, which is

Prior Learning:

- Children recognise some key Bible stories learnt in KS1 or EYFS
- Children know who key people are including Jesus and Prophet Muhammad.
- Children recognise and know what the Bible and Qur'an are and what they mean to Muslims and Christians around the world
- Children know and can explain when Muslims and Christians worshipas been studies so far but children may know others)
