"How is new life welcomed into the world?"

Core Learning of This Unit:

- Consider the concepts of welcome and celebration
- Consider a diverse range of views about the question, 'How should a baby be welcomed into the world?'
- Look at and consider some key events in the lives of believers;
- Think about their own experiences and views in relation to questions of how they were welcomed and celebrated when they were born and in relation to the experiences and views of people from the religions studied
- Children will look at the way different families and religions welcome new arrivals

Prior Learning:

From KS1: Children will have learnt about Islam and Christianity in detail including the key festivals celebrated

Children will know about key religious celebrations including some personal experiences.

All children will have visited a mosque, a church, a cathedral and a synagogue before Year 4.

Children will have previously looked at baptism within a Year 2 unit.
