# **Core Learning of This Unit:**

• Explore Jesus' teachings and how they inspire Christians today. Consider the extent to which Jesus' values and example would benefit today's world.

• Love: use some of Jesus' stories, teachings and example to understand what Christians believe he meant by loving others

• Forgiveness: use some of Jesus' stories, teachings and example to understand why he saw forgiveness as so important

• Justice and fairness: use some of Jesus' stories, teaching and examples to understand the way Christians believe we should treat each other

• Generosity and not being greedy: use some of Jesus' stories, teaching and examples to understand the way Christians believe we should handle wealth

### **Prior Learning:**

From KS1: Children will have learnt about Islam and Christianity in detail including the key festivals celebrated

Children will have studied and will have knowledge of at least 4 major world religions. Christianity will have been studied in detail from Reception.

All children will have visited a mosque, a church, a cathedral, a gurdwara and a synagogue before Year 5
