RECEPTION HOME LEARNING



Here is an overview of the tasks we would like the children to be completing at home this week alongside our Phonics, Action Words/Maths and Story Time LIVE SESSIONS. The challenges highlighted are aligned to the characteristics of effective learning in the Early Years and work towards the Early Learning Goals. This week our core text is 'The Little Green Hen' as a starting point to our new learning theme 'The Circle of Life'. You can listen to me reading this story on Tapestry.

Mental health and well-being

Challenge 1 Talk about returning to School on the 8th of March. Feelings, thoughts, memories, worries and hopes. Try on School uniform/PE Kit and shoes/trainers. Prepare book bags. Upload a photo and information to Tapestry.

Challenge 2 Gardening. Dig, plant seeds, feed, nurture and care for your garden.

Challenge 3 Go on a sensory walk. (Use your senses to observe the weather and your surroundings - see, hear, smell, touch, taste).

Art / Creative

Challenge 1 'Worm' Art. Use string or cooked pasta. See Tapestry for details.

Challenge 2 'Sheep Art' Use wool to weave. See Tapestry for details.

Investigation/ICT

Challenge 1 Find out about animal and plant life cycles.

Challenge 2 Talk about and observe the features of plants and flowers.

Literacy Reading

The Little Green Hen by Alison Murray.

Listen to me reading the story. Discuss the events and characters in the story. What was the problem? What happened at the beginning, middle and end?

Action Words

Focus on reviewing Action Words (1.1-1.9). Play Action Word 'scavenger hunt', 'sock splat' and 'Bingo' games. Join in LIVE ACTION WORDS at 1pm every day.

RWI Phonics Join in LIVE PHONICS sessions every day at 9am to review and learn set 1 or 2 sounds. Read the sound blending (1-10) or Red / green Ditty book in your reading folder every day.

Literacy Writing

Challenge 1 Draw and label a story map / poster about 'The Little Green Hen'.

Challenge 2 Create a 'remote learning' scrap book with photos, drawings and labels/sentences. What did you enjoy? What did you learn?

Practise writing capital and lowercase letters. Use the links provided on Tapestry or the worksheets in your home learning pack.
