Staffing All our teachers and teaching assistants work closely in teams to deliver the best quality-first teaching to our children. We always focus on diagnosing and filling any gaps in learning for individual children through targeted teaching and interventions. In Upper Key Stage 2 Miss Karlsson and Mrs Hart are now working exclusively with Year 6, and Mr Palin and Mrs Longley are working in Year 5 with Mrs Smith and Mrs Holmes also providing valuable extra support.

Wraparound Care. Breakfast club and After school club are now running for normal hours . Following
