#### **Dear Parents**

#### Full reopening on Monday 8th March

Full details of the reopening will follow however we will have staggered start and end times just as we did in the Autumn term to aid social distancing. Please use these times so that we can protect valuable teaching time. Where siblings have different timings, please aim for the middle (8:45 and 3:15).

Year 1,3,5,6—Drop off 8:30—8:45 AM Pick up: 3:00—3:15 PM

Reception, Year 2 and 4 — Drop off 8:45—9:00 AM Pick up: 3:15—3:30 PM

From March 8th Wraparound Care at Breakfast and After School Club will revert to normal hours. Bookings for this can now be made.

#### **World Book Day**

Next Friday is World Book Day at JCA. This year's celebrations are going to be slightly different. Learning will have a book focus based on a text of the teacher's choice. We would usually ask children to dress up but this year we know this is not feasible for all. If your child does want

to dress up or wear an accessory representing their favourite text that would be most encouraged. Book vouchers will be given out once we return to school. These can be used at local bookshops. Darling Reads, a local bookshop in Horbury, are accepting these before shops open if that helps.




