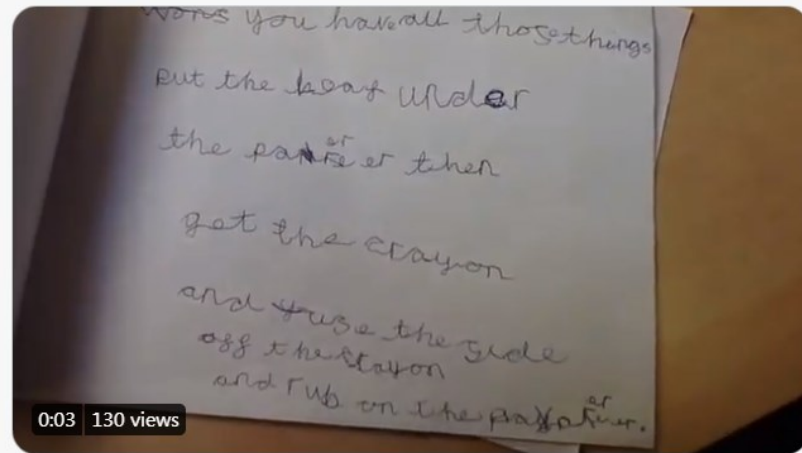

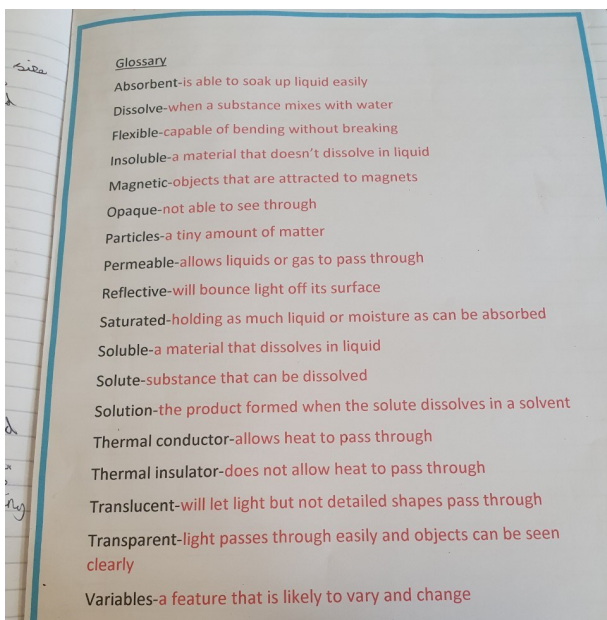

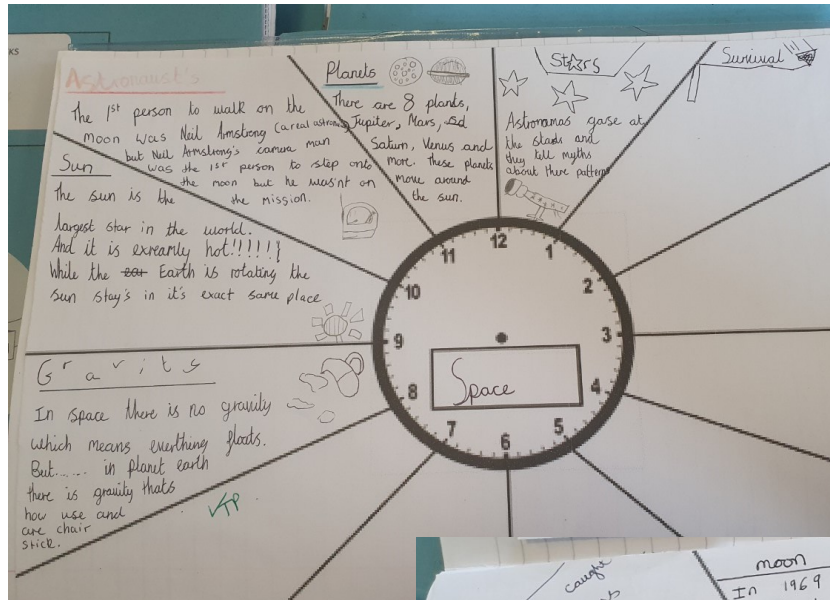

Helping children to create their own vocabulary books or lists can support them in creating links between different and support them to to remember and use in their explanations.





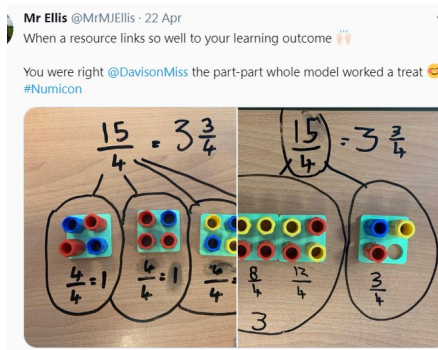
Some fantastic retrieval clocks about Space to view children's existing knowledge. These can, of course, be reviewed and re-visited throughout the topic and the year.
