Subject: Science (Seasonal Changes) Year Group: 1 Term: Autumn/ Spring

Core Learning of This Unit:

- To know that weather is the way the air and the atmosphere feels.
- To learn about the four seasons: Spring, Summer, Autumn and Winter
- To know that we call the general weather trends and the extremes of weather in one place a 'climate'.
- To explore that when something blocks light travelling from a source, a shadow is made
- To know that colder weather comes in Autumn and Winter and warmer weather comes in Spring and Summer.
