

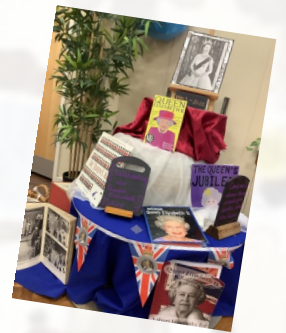


The Queen's Platinum Jubilee at Jerry Clay Academy
