Subject Unit Overview

Subject: RE Year Group: 5 Term: Summer 2
"What does it mean to be a Muslim in Britain today?"

Core Learning of This Unit:

- Explore the practice, meaning and significance of the Five Pillars of Islam as an expression of ibadah. How do these affect the lives of Muslims, moment by moment, daily, annually, in a lifetime?
- Think about and discuss the value and challenge for Muslims of following the Five Pillars, and how they might make a difference to individual Muslims and to the Muslim community
- Consider what beliefs, practices and values are significant in pupils' lives.
- Consider the importance of the Holy Qur'an for Muslims: how it was revealed to the Prophet Muhammad, how it is used, treated, learnt.
- Find out about the difference between the authority of the Qur'an and other forms of guidance for Muslims: Sunnah and Hadith

Prior Learning:

From KS1: Children will have learnt about Islam and Christianity in detail including the key festivals celebrated

Children will have studied and will have knowledge of at least 4 major world religions. Islam will have been studied at three different points before this unit.

All children will have visited a mosque, a church, a cathedral, a gurdwara and a synagogue before Year 5
