Subject: PE – OAA **Year Group:** Year 2 **Term:** Summer

Core Learning of This Unit:

- Follow simple directions and marked routes on the school sites.
- Use pictorial and diagrammatic map references.
- Orientate themselves successfully within a confined space using simple references and basic compass bearings.
- Respond to references, signs, keys and symbols.
- Explore and talk about possible alternative responses to simple choice options.
- Use appropriate technical language, route, symbol, and obstacle.
- Make suggestions on how they might improve their own and others' work.
- Follow simple rules and safety procedures.

Prior Learning:

- Identify where they are by using simple plans and diagrams of familiar environments.
- Use simple plans and diagrams to help them follow a short trail and go from one place to another.
- Respond to a challenge or problem they are set.
- Begin to work and behave safely.
- Work increasingly co-operatively with others, discussing how to follow trails and solve problems.
- Recognise that different tasks make their body work in different ways.
- Comment on how they went about tackling tasks.
