



Reception Class Learning

Lighthouse Keepers Lunch

On Monday we shared 'The Lighthouse Keepers Lunch' story and we learnt key phrases from the character Mr Grinling such as 'Lackaday Lackaday' and 'Clear off you varmints!'. We have also been learning to use key vocabulary such as 'devoured' and 'industrious' within our play. During the week,

we have been busy preparing Mr Grinling's





In Maths, we are learning to add so that Mr Grinling can find the total number of people arriving at the lighthouse. We played a game called 'Mr Grinling's boats' to practise adding 2

groups of children together. The children are becoming experts at accurately counting to find the total.

Literacy

This week we have used our phonic knowledge and Action Words to write a sentence about our World Book Day costume. The children are striving to use capital letters, finger spaces and full stops as well as spell their Action words correctly. Fabulous!



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The children have been reading and re telling stories that they have read in School such as Tiddler and The Rainbow Fish and also striving to read 'memory books' about their previous learning in School.

Physical Development

In PE, the children became pirates and played a game called 'steal the treasure'. The children worked together in teams to quickly take treasure back to their treasure chests and steal treasure from their opposing teams to gain extra points. The children really enjoyed racing against each other to win points and showed fabulous teamwork. We sang a Sea Shanty song as we raced against each other — Pirate patch, Pirate hat, swashbuckler cheer Aha! Lots of excitement and great fun. On Tuesday, the children enjoyed an extra PE session with ACE sports working on their fundamental movement and ball skills.

Music / Singing

This week, the children have learnt to sing 'A Sailor went to Sea, Sea, Sea'- a catchy sea shanty song! We are looking forward to performing this to you at Friday Library. A video will also be available to view on Tapestry next week.
