Subject: History **Year Group**: Year 6 **Term**: Summer 1

Main strands within this History unit

Government /Monarchy	 Children will learn about parliamentary Monarchy and how the Kings or Queens at the time ruled and were in charge of laws The children will learn about Henry VIII and how he changed the way of ruling
Relgion	 The children will learn about the religions at the time and how Catholicism was prominent in England at that time Children will learn about Henry VIII'S wives and how this brought on the reformation of the churches The children will learn about the start of the Church of England strand of Christianity
Society	 Children will learn about William Shakespeare and his playwrights and how the society enjoyed them. Children will learn about William Shakespeare's impact on society increasing the language used and the importance they still have today
