### Core Learning of This Unit:

Children use their theme of **Dungeons and Dragons** to help create a **watercolour painting**

### Prior Learning:

- Uses a variety of tools to spread paint, e.g. straws, matchsticks, brush
- Explores use of thick brushes, foam and sponge
- Experiments with colours
- Line drawing work from EYFS.
