### Significant Artist and Key Artist Knowledge

**A sculptor** is someone who creates sculptures. **Sculptures** are solid objects that represent a thing, person, or idea and are made out of materials. **Darrell Wakelam** is a 3D sculptor who uses the medium of recyclable, sustainable materials (mainly scraps of cardboard) to create his projects. He was born in the West Midlands, UK and is often inspired by animals and nature.
