Subject: Art Year Group: 3 Term: Autumn

Core Learning of This Unit:

Children use their **theme** of **The Lost World** to produce a piece of **collage/texture work**.
Core learning is taken from the 'Drawing' and 'Wider media' sections of the programme of study 2023:

Prior Learning:

- Sketching techniques of hatching, cross-hatching, stippling, scumbling.
- Experimenting with 3D art as part of individual and whole-class pieces.

Significant Artist and Key Artist Knowledge

A sculptor is someone who creates sculptures. **Sculptures** are solid objects that represent a thing, person, or idea and are made out of materials. **Darrell Wakelam** is a 3D sculptor who uses the medium of recyclable, sustainable materials (mainly scraps of cardboard) to create his projects. He was born in the West Midlands, UK and is often inspired by animals and nature.
