Introduction of a new system – Medical Tracker

From Monday we will be launching a new electronic First Aid system.

If your child has medication stored at school, we will send an email notification as soon as medication has been administered to make you aware this has taken place. This email notification will come from a programme called Medical Tracker and will be sent to the email address we have on file for you – please contact the Office should you wish to check the email address we have on record for you or need to amend your email address.

If your child has an accident at school we will send you an email notification of a minor incident – this will replace the current physical bump forms that come home with your child.

If your child has an accident where they may have received a mark, head injury or we feel you need to be made aware of we will continue to make telephone contact.
