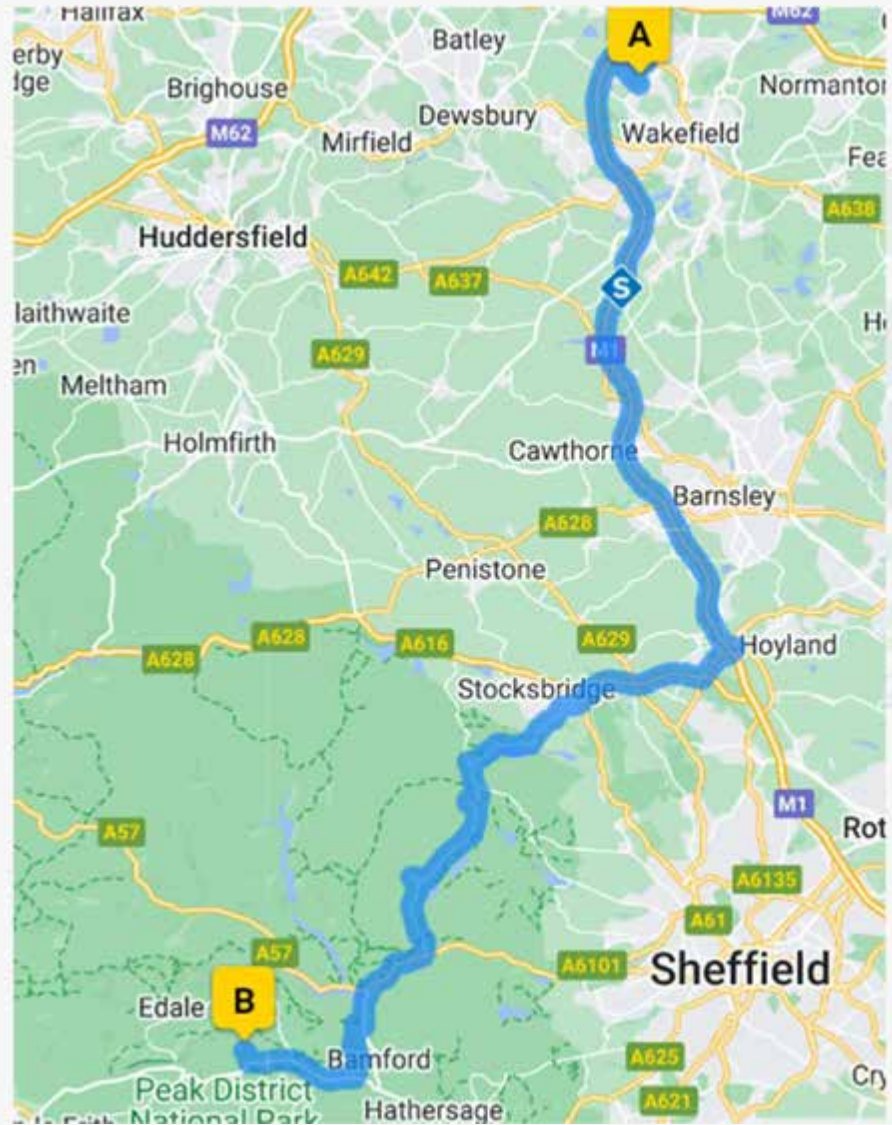

The class will be mainly together and led by a qualified instructor(s) from YHA Castleton.

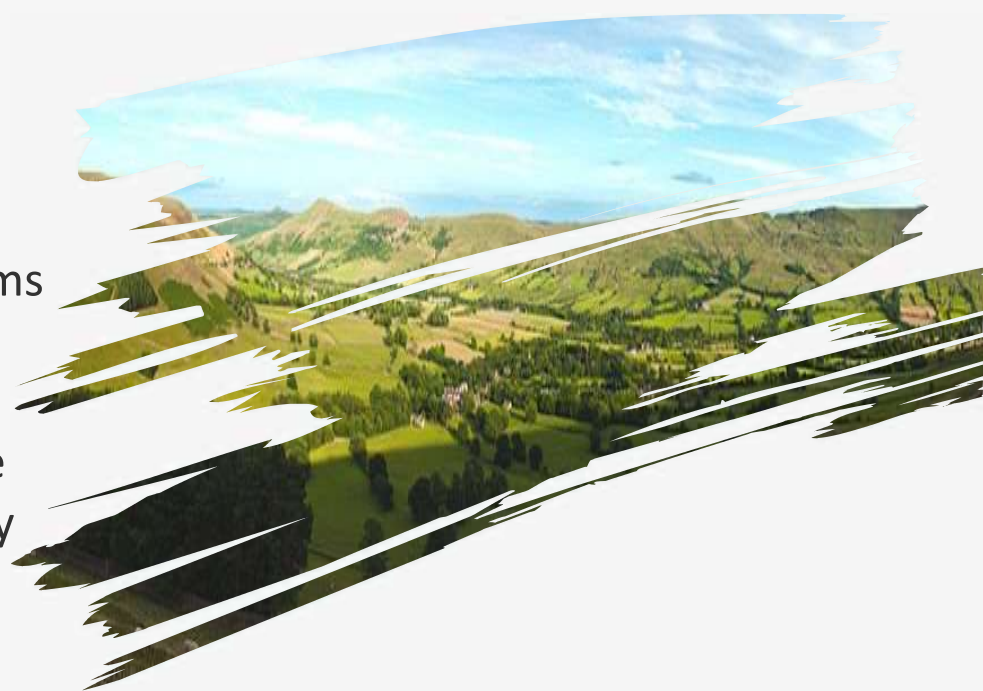

What to pack...

- All children need a small holdall or suitcase with them (that they can carry!).
- All children need inhalers, medicine (e.g. travel sickness tablets/hayfever/eczema) with them. A member of staff will take all medication from you on the morning of the visit and put them into named bags. There is a Jerry Clay form to fill in for this.
- Please make sure that you send your child with sun cream and hats. We are outside most of the day!
- Aerosols are NOT allowed. If children want to use deodorants (which we advise) they need to be roll on.
- Clothing can be damaged so please do not send anything you would not like ruined. Please make sure all clothing is clearly labelled with your child's name (especially jumpers!).



Eating

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- ALL children will choose their food options from a menu of meals. Children have plenty of fruit available to have as they wish. They also have freshly made puddings each day or ice cream if they choose this option.
- Drinks are available throughout the day,
- Breakfast will consist of a range of cereals, toast, fruit and yoghurts.
- YHA Castleton have sent the dietary information and children whom this concerns will be made aware of this.



What to bring

- Children are NOT allowed to bring mobiles, iPads, iPhones or anything that requires a plug. They will not have the time or energy to do anything but sleep on a night.
- Children are welcome to bring soft toys or comfort blankets with them.
- Children will not be able to make any contact with home during the trip.
- If there is a problem, Miss Karlsson/Mr Palin will let you know. PLEASE keep your mobile phone nearby and turned on if this is the emergency contact number you have given.
- Children can bring a maximum of £5 for souvenirs. (In change if possible)
